

We are pleased to announce the successful start of an Erasmus MUNDUS project for a Master of Science in Applied Cybersecurity, titled CyberMACS. Involved are the Kadir Has University, Istanbul, Turkey as the coordinating university and Faculty of Computer Science and Engineering, Ss. Cyril and Methodius University in Skopje, North Macedonia and SRH Berlin, Germany as partners. In addition, other outstanding partners in academia and industry in Turkey, North Macedonia, Germany as well as, Estonia and the Netherlands are involved in the project.

CyberMACS is a two-year joint European full-time master program (120 ECTS) with a focus on "Applied Cybersecurity". It provides a solid background in cybersecurity, with a focus on training future cybersecurity experts to detect, prevent, and manage cyberattacks. All students are trained in the basics of cybersecurity in the first year at Kadir Has in Istanbul. In the second year, students will specialize, going to either Berlin or Skopje. In addition, participation in winter/summer courses and a mandatory internship are planned. In addition to specialization tracks, such as Cyber Security Management, Advanced Technologies in Cybersecurity at SRH Berlin and Cryptology and Web and Cybersecurity at Ss. Cyril and Methodius University, students will be trained in soft skills as well as entrepreneurship and will complete their studies with a double diploma.

Prof. Dr. Hasan Dağ, Vice President of Kadir Has, is the project leader; at SRH Berlin, the project is coordinated by Prof. Dr. Reiner Creutzburg, and Prof. Dr. Vesna Dimitrova is project coordinator at Faculty of Computer Science and Engineering, Ss. Cyril and Methodius University in Skopje.
